 - Background Screen
 - SafeSport
 - These are required, you will be prompted to complete them as you go through the registration process
 - You are not eligible to officiate until these are completed

Candidate Certification Steps

- Watch on-line clinic:FL24_201 Adult New Referee Training
- Attend a new orientation meeting
- Take referee 801 Rules Exam
 - On-line "Correct as you go" format
- Accept invitation from ZebraWeb (ZW)
 - Sent via email after online clinic / test is completed
 - ZW availability is blocked for all officials. UNBLOCK the days you want to work. Watch for assignments from ZW for your evaluations
- Attend tournament for on-court evaluations
 - Wear uniform or similar clothing
 - 2 passing ratings as R1, 1 as R2



- There are several assigning systems.
 It is your responsibility to keep current on all of them
- Here are the accounts you will need

- Event Sanctions
 - Florida Region
 - USAV
 - AAU
 - Unsanctioned
- There are other sanctioning organizations
 - USA VOLLEYBALL Sunshine Qualifier
 - Apply on AES
 - AAU Volleyball
 - Various assignors



- Florida Region sanctioned events are in ZebraWeb
- See the list by going into ZW and selecting Games>Composite Schedule Search>view report.
 - This will show you all the tournaments being assigned by the Florida Region
- Decide which events you want to work
 - Preferences because systems don't give us that info
 - https://floridaregionofficials.weebly.com/tournamentpreferences.html



- SportWrench
 - Many tournaments listed there
 - Various sanctioning bodies
 - Apply supply information for each event
 - Status
 - Payment
- If you apply in SportWrench that means you want to work that weekend.
 - Your ZW will be adjusted to match
 - Your preferences will tell us which event you prefer to work



ZebraWeb

- Final assignments for FL Region USAV sanctioned tournaments come to you through ZebraWeb (ZW)
- You enter your availability into ZW
 - UNBLOCK days you CAN work
 - List of tournaments under Reports>composite schedule search
- Keep availability current in ZW
 - Critical to keep your availability current EVEN after you think assignments are DONE —we may need a last-minute replacement for someone



ZebraWeb

- If you turn back an assignment in ZW, you are required to supply a reason.
 - Reason can be brief, not too detailed
 - If you show as available, we expect you to accept the assignment
 - If you turn back too many assignments, it could potentially impact future assignments.



Assignment Etiquette

- If you accept an assignment you are obligated
 - Can't switch for a better deal
 - No secrets in the volleyball world
 - If something comes up, be honest, and do it right away
 - Sometimes assignors will negotiate on your behalf to make it work



Tournaments

- Usually assigned based on geography
 - Sometimes there is another webpage for preferences
 - https://floridaregionofficials.weebly.com
- Tournament pay varies by event
 - match pay rate is determined by the tournament host.
- Hotels may be available if >50 miles
 - One way mileage
 - Smaller events may not offer hotels.
 - Must be over 18 or stay in room with a related working referee
 - Shared room with another official
 - Roommate preferences 3-4 weeks out



Florida Region Referees must know how to keep score!

Watch scoring clinic on-line as part of new referee curriculum

 Referees need to be comfortable with the scoring process



- Upon successful completion of candidate process, you will be awarded a Provisional patch.
- Follow recertification process detailed on-line each year.
- Advancement opportunities
 - Two seasons experience recommended
 - Notify Officials Coordinator or Chair



Professionalism

- First impressions are important!
- Look the part proper uniform, neat, clean, pressed
- Act the part not overly friendly with teams or coaches, even if you know them well
- Alert Head Ref of any close conflict situations (club affiliations or your child playing on a team in that pool or age group)
- Remember that someone is ALWAYS watching you!



Know the Rules!

- Keep current with interpretations

- Do your job but don't be overly officious

A great start to every match

- Be on time and manage time throughout the day
- Brief work team every time (but be "brief!")
- Check ground rules, uniforms, etc well before start time
- Make sure line ups are correct avoid problems later



Match Control

- Time management
 - Every two or three minutes add up over a long day!
- Participant management
 - Use your tools (cards and verbal warnings)
 - Protect your officiating team
 - Protests or Issues send someone for head referee



- Look for Learning Opportunities
 - Be a student of the game
 - Seek out mentors
 - Learn at least one thing from every match!
 - Talk to other referees, not about other referees!
 - Any uncomfortable or inappropriate behavior gets reported to the head referee, tournament director or region office!
- Work on getting your name and face known
 - Volunteer as R2 to get in practice
